
Call & Response

Call to Worship

We are called to be the people of God, called together to be the community of people who follow the way of Christ, called to be responsive to the Spirit.

We gather as that community: **Let us worship God.**

Sometimes we are overly arrogant and fail to recognise the learning we need to respond more effectively to your call. Had the first disciples forgotten what needed to be learnt the message of hope may have been stifled.

So forgive us, loving God, when we do not want to learn with you.

Help us to discern afresh how you would have us work together to be your people of the Way.

Help us discern once more how we are called in our context to share your love in our world. Amen.
